

The case involved what should have been a routine 2009 circumcision of a three day old boy at Wilkes-Barre General Hospital by second year medical resident. "Our lawsuit charged the doctor with removing too much skin from a three day old infant," said Attorney John R. Lenahan. "The young boy had to undergo a reconstructive surgical procedure at another facility. The jury on this case had to review a great deal of highly technical medical negligence testimony and after careful deliberation, returned a verdict for our client in the amount of \$570,000."

To help prove his case, John Lenahan called in expert testimony from a plastic surgeon, a pediatric urologist and a pediatric psychiatrist. "This case is an example of the type of resources you need to bring to bear when suing a hospital or a large insurance company," said Attorney Lenahan. "The verdict will bring closure to the family and I'm honored to have played a role."
